I honestly believe that Solar Hydrogen could become *the key technology* to avert the worst consequences of climate change.

(My apologies to those who paid for the first edition. There were several errors that I corrected. The biggest change was the elimination of the section on Hawaii. I inadvertently used the land area for the entire state and not just Oahu in my original calculations. It turns out that there is *not* enough area on Oahu to comfortably generate all electricity on the island using only PV solar arrays. I still think that Hawaii would be a good location for demonstrating solar hydrogen if we included other renewables such as wind, OTEC and wave energy. Unfortunately, I do not have the resources to estimate the magnitude of these other renewables, but the high electricity prices in Hawaii should provide a good return on investment for renewable hydrogen plants.)
